*) Rules of the relays

The combined age of the relay swimmers must not exceed 51 years (YOB is seen as age for this).

If multiple teams of the same club are entered in the same event, these are prior to the race to be indicated as Team1, Team 2 etc.

The names of each swimmer in a relay are to be written on a race slip and handed to the announcer. For the Freestyle relay prior to Event 12 (100m Breaststroke) and for the IM relay prior to Event 18 (100m Freestyle). Results:

Results of the individual races will be held in each year of birth.

HEAD - Cup:

The Cup is awarded to the highest points achieved by a male and female swimmer YOB 2009 and older, as well as YOB 2010 and younger. The 25m events are not included in this.

Trophies for 1st place in the male and female Free and IM relays.

Special prices::

Happy-HEAD-heats: At least one heat in every event except relay events will be picked at random. The winner of that heat will receive a special prize.

General Rules::

1. Swimmers born in the year 2005-2012, who are registered with the DSV and have paid the license for 2019 or are members of a FINA registers association, are eligible to compete. Swimmer from ages 8 to 10 can not compete in more than 6 events, including relays per day. (WP according to §12(2) WB-AT dated 04.11.2016

The Competition will be held according to WB, of the RO, ADO and WLO of the DSV - entitled to compete are all swimmers, whose BSV club is in possession of the association privileges.

2. All events will use the one-start-rule (WB §125 Abs.6).

3. Entry fees::

25m events 4.00€

4. all other events: 6.00€ per individual start

11.00€ per relay team

The entry fee is to be paid be a check or in cash on the competition day. Alternatively the entry fee can be transferred to the account IBAN: DE46 7009 3400 0100 6008 30; BIC GENODEF1ISV; VR-Bank Ismaning Hallbergmoos Neufahrn eG.

5. Entries:

Please use the entry list DSV-Form 102 and the entry file DSV-Form 101. The ability to compete must be confirmed on the entry file of every competing swimmer (WB AT § 11).

The ID number of the athletes is to be given on the entry file.

We ask all clubs to please send the entries in an electronic copy (DSV6 Standard or LXF) via email.

6. **Provision:**

We reserve the right to reject entries based on the spatial and time limitations. In the case of this the date of the entry will be considered.

7. Entry deadline:

29.11.2019

Late entries or follow up entries are not possible.

8. Officials:

Every competing club must provide at least one official (more than 30 entries 2 officials. The officials are to be named with their preferred function in the entry file.

This rule does not apply to foreign clubs.

Official and team manager meeting commences 30 min prior to competition start.









9. Medaillen und Urkunden:

The places 1-3 of every event will receive a medal. The medals are to be collected on the competition day. Certificates are available to download for approx.14 days after the competition on our homepage.

- 10. The results will be sent out via e-mail as a pdf and dsv6-document. A paper form of the results will not be provided.
- 11. Sport merchandise:
 - In the foyer products of **SCHWIMMProfi Obermair** will be available for sale.
- 12. We will not take any liability for lost property.
- 13. It is not allowed to enter the pool with outdoor footwear or clothes.
- 14. **approach / Parking:** It is requested to arrive by public transport if possible. Giesing train station (S-Bahn: S3, S7, Underground U2, U7, Tram: 17, Bus: 54, 59, 139, 147) is only 300 meters from the education center. There are only a few parking slots directly in front of the education center. Parking slots are available at the weekend at Werinherstraße crossing Schlierseestraße. Please also use the extensive Park & Ride offer of the MVV.
- 15. **privacy protection** Host and Meet Director process personal data provided by the clubs / starting communities in the context of the entries for this competition. The data is stored and processed for the creation of a registration result, for the preparation of minutes, the posting of results, for the award ceremony, for the creation of certificates, record lists, best lists and for publication on the Internet (live timing, meeting minutes, event homepage, association homepage, DSV portal). Before, during and after the event these data will also be used for correspondence with the registered clubs / starting communities, for media coverage and for communication with the swimming federations.

Photos, films or photomechanical reproductions taken during the event may be used by the Host and Meet Director and authorized third parties such as media and sponsors without compensation claims of the respective participant or his legal representative.

Unauthorized third parties have no access to the stored personal data. The data will be stored and used by the Host and Meet Director and commissioned service providers for as long as it is necessary for their purposes.

By submitting the entries, the clubs / starting communities agree to the storage, processing and use of personal data for all registered participants. In the case of underage participants, the registering clubs / starting communities are responsible for obtaining the consent of a legal representative. Every participant or his legal representative can object to the storage, processing and use of personal data in whole or in part at any time in writing to the organizer and demand their deletion. Possible consequences result from the competition regulations of the German Swimming Association.

16. License: This competition is licensed by the BSV (DSV).
